**Approve Minutes – April, 2012**

Don moved, Joe seconded to approve the minutes. Passed unanimously.

**BUSINESS**

Scott has not heard from Mayor Hutton regarding an appointment to replace John Oberle whose term expires 12/31/2013.

Scott reviewed the commission's role in evaluating National Register nominations and passed out sheets on *Criteria for Evaluation and Results of Listing in the National Register* from the office of the IN DHPA. He discussed what Section 106 review is and explained that properties that have been identified as eligible for the National Register are reviewed for impact on historic integrity but only when federal funds are used. Properties listed in the National Register are eligible for a small matching grant fund if they are owned by tax exempt entities.

Some commission members were unable to open or print the nomination so Scott will print and mail the nomination so it can be reviewed before next month's meeting.

Regarding funding for Historic Richmond Today, Scott Bartle will make a list of items salvaged from the North 9<sup>th</sup> Street properties to make available for donations which can go to editing costs. Jill reported the following email from John Oberle. "We are planning to shoot the next HRT show with Sue King at the MRL. Historic Tour. At the moment we plan to shoot this on June 10th to air Monday June 25th. After the current show plays out we will present a re-run to fill the space till then. I will coordinate with Jill Nelson who will keep the commission in the loop."

Jill and Scott Bartle discussed Linden Hill Conservation District as a Local Historic District. Jill and Scott Bartle have worked on a list of items that would be reviewed with property owners interested in being in a local historic district. Property owners need to know what items of exterior rehabilitation would be reviewed by the commission. We need to review them in July after addressing the Richmond High School NR nomination.

Don moved and Joe seconded to adjourn at 6:10. Motion passed.
