Tis' the season for holiday get togethers! Many families, businesses, and organizations will hold holiday parties and provide those attending with beverages that come in glass, plastic, and aluminum containers. Did you know:

- Glass never wears out and can be recycled forever?
- Plastics bottles and jars numbered 1 (HDPE) and 2 (PETE) are the most desired containers recycled and collected for reuse?
- When you recycle one aluminum can that metal can be made into a new can AND be back on the store shelf in 3 months!

Remember: Recycling is a good habit to get into especially this time of the year. U.S. household waste generally increases by 25% during the holiday season.
