PSA: New Year's Recycling Resolution

Want to start recycling but overwhelmed by the thought of keeping everything straight? Start small and then add a new item each month and soon it will become second nature. Recycling metal cans are an easy way to begin. Many food items come in steel cans such as fruits, vegetables, and soups. Aluminum cans are still used for many types of beverages. Once the cans are empty just rinse them out (to reduce pests) and put them in your recycle bin. Once you feel comfortable recycling your metal containers for a month or so add another item, like glass bottles and jars. Remove the lid (many of them are made of steel) and like before rinse them both before placing in your recycle bin. If you are in Richmond and need a container for your recyclable materials call the Richmond Sanitary District at 765-983-7450 and request a blue Richie Roller for your curbside pickup.
