PSA: Fall Stormwater

Fall is the time for many businesses and homeowners to clean up and put summer equipment, vehicles, and furniture away for the season. As you are preparing to do these jobs please keep these simple tips in mind to help keep pollutants out of the storm drains and our local waterways:

- Wash and clean equipment and furniture on grassy areas to allow soap and dirt to filter through soil instead of running down the pavement to the nearest storm drain.
- Wash your convertible, motorcycles, and summer use vehicles at a commercial car wash where the soap suds and dirt that enter the floor drain go to a wastewater treatment plant for cleaning before re-entering our local river.

Remember: ONLY RAIN IN THE STORM DRAIN – anything else is a pollutant that degrades water quality and is harmful to aquatic life. Brought to you by the City of Richmond and the Richmond Sanitary District
